- Candidates No. 2 are exempt from TOEFL and IELTS.
- Candidates No. 3 with a TOEFL score 580 are not required to register for additional English language courses.

**ENROLLMENT**

All candidates are required to contact the Educational Service Division (4<sup>th</sup> floor of Narathip Bongsrabandha Building) for enrollment and course registration on 7-11 January 2019. The following documents must be submitted during the enrollment process:

- 2 copies of bachelor's graduation certificate
- 2 copies of master's graduation certificate
- 2 copies of bachelor's degree transcripts
- 2 copies of master's degree transcripts
- 2 photos (1 inch)
- A medical certificate issued by a physician or a medically qualified healthcare provider which certifies that you are free of contagious diseases or other serious health conditions that can interfere with your study. This medical certificate can be requested at any private or public hospitals and clinics and must be valid within one month only.

- 2 copies of passport (foreign candidates) or ID card (Thai candidates)
- 1 copies of household registration (Thai candidates)
- Where applicable: An official document indicating name/family name changes and marriage certificate
- All foreign students must have valid health insurance throughout the entire duration of their studies
- Candidates who received their bachelor or master's degree from foreign universities abroad are also required to submit during the enrollment process:
