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The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Public Administration Program (English Program) MPA-Public Policy and Strategic Management for the academic year 1/2020.

### **1. Qualification of Applicants**

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or are studying in last semester (and to graduate before first intake start) in any field from a university or institution accredited by the Commission on Higher Education.

1.2 Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for received degrees that is issued by Commission on Higher Education.

### **2. Application Forms**

2.1 Applications forms can be obtained by contacting the Educational Service Division, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs. (Except government holidays) or the Graduate School of Public Administration, 10<sup>th</sup> Floor, Navamindradhiraj Building, NIDA Seri Thai Road, Bangkapi District, Bangkok.

2.2.1 Download the application form and print out on A4 paper only, do not change the format of the form; otherwise, it will not be accepted for the application process.

### **3. Application procedure and Payment of Fees**

Applications accompanied by an application fee of 200 baht, must be submitted to the Educational Service Division, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Prince Naradhip Bongsprabandha Building between 8.30 – 16.30 hrs. (Except government holidays).

### **4. Required Documents**

- 4.1 Completed application form
- 4.2 Bachelor's Degree diploma (2 Copies)
- 4.3 Complete official transcript(s) of undergraduate studies (1 copy)
- 4.4 Copy of personal identity card (if applicable)
- 4.5 Copy of passport (for Non-Thai applicants)
- 4.6 Evidence of any change of name (if applicable)
- 4.7 One 1-inch photo taken no more than six months prior to application date
- 4.8 For applicants who graduate from an institute outside Thailand:

4.8.1 A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for the Bachelor's Degree. 4.8.2 An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:

4.9 Applicants are required to submit a test score of either 500 for TOEFL, 5.5 IELTS, 500 NIDA TEAP or the Test of English Proficiency that conducted by

standard organization or representative of the government from applicants' country (Applicant might get the permission to not provide evidence of English Proficiency or might require to attend English Foundation in case of failure from this English criteria, considered by course committee and shall approve by the Dean.

*Note:* 1) The documents mentioned in 4.8.1 and 4.8.2 above, must be submitted before the start of the first semester. Applicants who fail to submit all required documents will not be admitted to the program.

2) In case applicant has already been accepted but the document in 4.8.1 is disqualified by the approval of Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education, student status will be automatically terminated, or subject to NIDA council's discretion.

3) Evidence of English Literature must be submitted before first semester ends.



If an applicant has already been accepted but is subsequently determined to be disqualified, scholarship awards will automatically be canceled.
