Students must select 2 out of 4 questions to answer in the examination booklet. The examination is to test the students' mastery, integration and application of knowledge across the entire curriculum.

2nd Category

Date: 8th March 2026

Time: 09.00-12.00

- (1) Policy Implementation and Evaluation
- (2) Project Planning, Analysis, and Management
- (3) Crisis and Disaster Management

Students must select 2 out of 4 questions to answer in the examination booklet. The examination is to test the students' mastery, integration and application of knowledge across the entire curriculum.

Assessment criteria: Students must obtain an average grade of B or above in each category to pass the comprehensive examination. Students who do not meet this requirement must retake only the category in which the grade is below B.
