Remarks:

1) NIDA reserves the right to cancel the enrollment of any program that does not meet the minimum required number of registered students. In such cases, the program will be offered in the subsequent semester.

2) All selected applicants are required to register for the following courses in Semester 2 of Academic Year 2026:

LC 4001 Reading Skills Development in English for Graduate Studies
LC 4002 Integrated English Language Skills Development

The above requirement may be waived if selected applicants submit proof of English proficiency as follows:

2.1 Eligible English proficiency test score as specified below by Semester 1 of Academic Year 2026. The test score must be valid at the time of submission (Validity Period: 2 years from the test date, and 1 year for NIDA TEAP)

2.2 A Bachelor's or Master's degree certificate indicating that the program was conducted in English (English-medium instruction), with graduation not exceeding three (3) years prior to the date of student registration. The applicant must have obtained a minimum cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 scale) of 2.75 for a Bachelor's degree or 3.25 for a Master's degree.

Instruction for student registration

1) Required documents for registration:

- 1.1 Complete official transcript of Bachelor's Degree (2 copies).
- 1.2 Bachelor's Degree certificate (2 copies).
- 1.3 House registration certificate (1 copy - for Thai citizen only).
- 1.4 Identification card or copy of passport (2 copies).
- 1.5 A medical certificate issued by a licensed physician or qualified healthcare provider certifying that the applicant is free from contagious diseases or any serious medical conditions that may interfere with their studies is required. The certificate may be obtained from any public or private hospital or clinic and must have been issued no more than one (1) month prior to the date of submission.
- 1.6 Three (3) 1-inch photos taken no more than six (6) months prior to the submission date.
- 1.7 Evidence of name change (2 copies) (if applicable).
- 1.8 Applicants who are currently employed must submit a letter of approval granting permission to pursue full-time study, duly issued and endorsed by their employing organization.
- 1.9 All international students are strongly encouraged to maintain valid health insurance coverage throughout the entire duration of their studies; while not mandatory, it is highly recommended.
- 1.10 Complete the student card form at <https://edserv.nida.ac.th/wp-content/uploads/2024/03/fm-esd-03-02-en.pdf> (Please leave the Student ID section blank for the officer to fill in).
- 1.11 According to the Personal Data Protection Act, B.E. 2562 (2019), which comes into effect from June 1, 2022, the National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) requires student consent for the disclosure of educational information to a third party for the purpose of educational and/or academic document verification. A student can choose to use the consent form for

2) Additional required documents for applicants who graduated with a Bachelor’s degree from the institute outside Thailand:

For applicants who graduate from an institute outside Thailand, must also provide these following documents:

2.1 A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for the Bachelor’s Degree. This can be obtained from the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Higher Education Commission, Ministry of Education. 2.2 An official documentation certifying graduation from a public university, issued by the university or a relevant government authority; or

2.3 An official documentation certifying graduation from a university accredited by internationally recognized standards, such as AUN-QA, AACSB, or equivalent accreditation.

2.4 An official letter of certification for the Bachelor’s Degree with the University Council’s approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant’s university to the address below, or email: priyaporn.jam@nida.ac.th.

Applicants may submit the documents listed in Section 2 during the first semester. Applicants who fail to do so will be considered to have withdrawn from the Institution’s enrollment list, and their status as NIDA students will be nullified.

In the event that an applicant has already been accepted but the document specified in Section 2.1 is deemed invalid by the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education, the student’s enrollment status will be automatically terminated or subject to the discretion of the NIDA Council.

Remarks:

1) The Educational Service Division reserves the right to verify all required documents mentioned above at any time. If any document is found to be incomplete, fraudulent, or counterfeit, or if the applicant fails to submit documents within the specified timeline, the student registration process will be void, and NIDA reserves the right not to refund any registration fees.

2) NIDA reserves the right to verify all documents submitted in Sections 1 and 2 at any time. If any document is subsequently found to be forged or altered without proper authorization from the Office of the Civil Service Commission, the student’s enrollment will be terminated, and the Institute may take appropriate action for fraud.

3) NIDA reserves the right to verify an applicant’s qualifications at any time. If it is later determined that the applicant does not meet the announced requirements, the student’s enrollment will be nullified, even if the student has previously been accepted.

4) Applicants who have not yet received their graduation approval may submit proof of anticipated graduation. Students must graduate before the start of the semester as specified in the NIDA academic calendar, and the proof of graduation must be submitted within six (6) weeks after the semester begins. Failure to submit the required documents by the deadline will result in the student’s enrollment being voided, and NIDA will not refund any fees.

Other important information & Scholarship conditions

1) The decision for English for Graduate Studies courses waiver will be made in accordance with the rules and regulations of the English Program at the Graduate School of Languages and Communication.

2) Study Period: This program is a two-year full-time program, with a maximum duration of five (5) years to complete graduation.

3) NIDA reserves the right to select the most qualified candidates based on the number of scholarship available for each school. Scholarship will be granted in accordance with NIDA's announced criteria. Candidates who are not eligible for a scholarship may still enroll as regular self-financed students.

4) Scholarship Type 2 recipients will be exempted from tuition fees only for the entire duration of the program (two academic years) but remain responsible for all other fees (no.1, 3-6 as specified in education fee details).

5) Criteria, term and conditions of scholarship is stipulated in NIDA's announcement at <https://nida.ac.th/wp-content/uploads/2024/06/Qualifications-requirements-conditions-for-scholarships.pdf>
